

Middle School Supply List

Remember, there is no need to buy these items if you already have some at home

PLEASE LABEL THESE FIRST THREE ITEMS

- 1. One jump drive (also called a zip drive or a flash drive)** (compatible with Mac 10.1 and Windows) **Must be brought to school and home everyday**. Please find a good way to attach this jump drive to your backpack or binder or wear it each day! This must be labeled.
- 2. A backpack or a small rolling suitcase**
- 3. Labeled water bottle everyday (NO EXCEPTIONS!)**

Please don't label all of these other items yet

- 1 box of Kleenex
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 ream white copy paper
- 1 pack of pencils with erasers and at least 3 pens
- 1 box of 100 clear plastic sheet protectors (heavyweight)
- One metal ruler with both metric and standard measurement

Humanities & Language Arts (please think green & reuse what you can from last year!)

- 1 binder (2" size)
- A three-ring, zipper pencil bag inside the binder
- 1 pack of loose-leaf lined paper (college or wide ruled) inside the binder
- 1 small pack of dry erase markers
- 2 packs of dividers
- 1 pack of post it notes- regular size
- 1 small pack of ultrafine black Sharpies
- 1 pack of graph paper- **no holes!**

Science & Math (please think green and reuse what you can!)

- One 2 inch binder with 1 pack of loose leaf filler paper inside
- A three-ring, zipper pencil bag inside the binder
- 1 spiral notebook
- 1 composition black and white notebook
- 1 pack of graph paper with holes
- 1 pack of 5 dividers
- 1 calculator
- 1 package of 10 pencils
- 1 small pencil sharpener which collects the shavings
- 1 pack of colored pencils

Japanese (only get these items if you are taking Japanese)

- Two-inch Binder
- 100 5"x3" index cards (blank)
- 1 pack of 100 loose leaf note paper (wide-ruled)
- 2 pencils or mechanical pencils with erasers

- 1 yellow hi-liter
- 1 zipper pencil case which can be attached to the binder

French (only get these items if you are taking French)

- 1 three ring binder (1.5")
- 1 package of dividers
- 1 zipper pencil case which can be attached to the binder
- 1 package of loose-leaf paper (lined and with holes)
- HS/College level French-English dictionary (not a student dictionary).

Spanish (only get these items if you are taking Spanish)

- 1" binder
- 1 zipper pencil case which can be attached to the binder
- 3-hole notebook Spanish dictionary that fits in your binder
- 1 pack of wide ruled notebook paper
- 3 dividers

Fine Art: These items must be brought in the first day of school for all MS students.

7th Grade: One 9 X 12 inch watercolor paper pad, one 8 pack of black sharpies (not fine point), drawing pencils (pencils with different hardness levels) and one white eraser.

8th Grade: One 12 x 16 inch watercolor paper pad and one 8 pack of colored sharpies (not fine point), drawing pencils (pencils with different hardness levels) and one white eraser.

Digital Photography (only for students not taking drama)

Required: Bring your own camera every Friday with a memory card and your own camera cable to upload pictures.

Physical Education (needed for all students for PE class every Tuesday & Weds.)

A pair of running shoes suitable for Phys. Ed. (to be left at school unless worn everyday)

Outdoor clothing to suit the weather and pants that allow for maximum movement

Drama / Expedition / Life Skills / Community Service / Moving Images

The school will provide you with everything you need for these classes

All middle school students also need inside shoes or slippers and a healthy lunch, snack and drink. Please include an ice pack if you wish to keep it cold.
